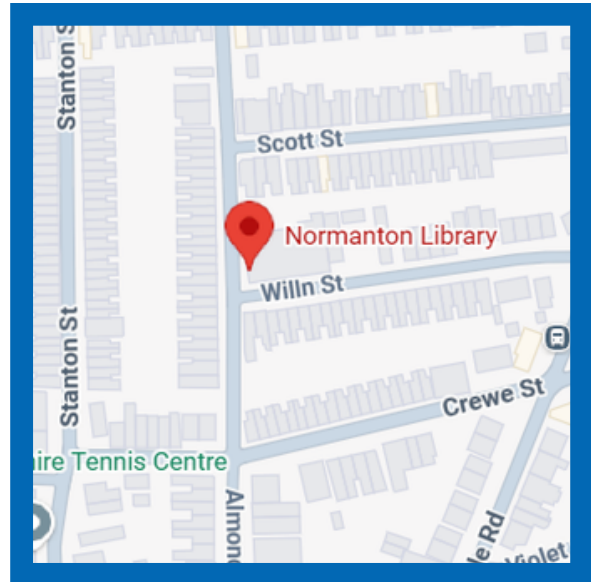


Normanton Library

By Car
